Update from GOP Convention - There were a lot of sparks during the Credentials committee report, because some of the delegates' applications were marked incorrectly or were not submitted before the deadline.

Elena was secretary of the Resolutions committee. There was a resolution supporting Israel and condemning Hamas for the Oct. 7th attack, which passed committee but failed on the floor, shockingly. One of the Resolutions which passed was advocating for switching to partisan municipal elections. Currently, local elections are "nonpartisan". Another opposed committee chairs holding bills in their desks instead of bringing them up for a vote, which causes bills to die without a hearing.
